STOP PRESS

This week all individual members and groups affiliated to EFDSS received a letter which outlined the changes which have been made to the Societies Public Liability Insurance policy. Among other things the letter lists what is covered and what is not covered by the PLI

One exemption is Products Liability (including food and drinks – outside catering companies should have their own insurance). Further clarification is required but it would seem that if someone attending a dance or other folk related activity has an adverse reaction to the food and drink provided by the host group and decides to take action against the group the Societies PLI will not cover the cost of defending that action and neither will it pay damages which might occur as a result of the action.

As a result of this some groups are considering engaging outside caterers or not providing food and drink at all. It is unclear whether issuing a disclaimer with the entrance ticket would be acceptable.

The letter suggests that individuals who want further clarification should consult efdss.org/insurance and also members will be able to contact the Societies Insurance Broker directly when the Society issues contact details.

I understand that the interval tea and biscuits which are provided by groups at their weekly meetings are not covered under this exemption. The exemption covers events where food and drink are purchased as part of the cost of the entrance ticket.

Dare I say food for thought?

Minutes of the 2018 AGM were agreed and there were no matters arising.

Treasurer's Report:- Cathy distributed the accounts for the year ending 30th September 2019 which showed a surplus of £48.30 which is a significant improvement on last year.

This was due to an increase in club subscriptions, and a reduction in web site fees and a reduction in printing and postage costs. We now have 106 members who receive MAD News and other information by email which has helped to reduce printing and postage costs. It was agreed to keep the annual MAD Folk affiliation fee at £12 for the coming year. Groups were reminded that affiliation fees are now due for payment.

Election of Officers: As there were no new nominations the officers were re-elected.

Mary thanked the officers for their work throughout the past year, David Haynes for looking after our website and Sheila Davies for her work in the production and distribution of MAD News.

ROY HORDLEY

15-03-1928 - 13-09-2019

I first encountered Roy at a barn dance which was held at a farm in Halewood near Liverpool. I did not know at the time that the man leading the Poachers Band, which included his wife Rene, was a man who had made a huge contribution to folk music and dance in the South Lancashire area.

Roy was an accomplished accordion and violin player. He led the Poachers Band for more than 50 years. In 1996 the band were recognised by the NSPCC for their work on behalf of the charity. Roy also played and danced with local Morris teams which included Manchester Morris.

Shortly after the end of WW2 Roy along with Vic Smeltzer formed the St. Helens Folk Dance Group. Roy was active within the group as a caller, musician and committee member until the group folded recently.

I became better acquainted with Roy and Rene when they led the Sunday morning workshop band. Roy was always helpful and supportive to all members of the group whatever their level of competence and gave them the opportunity to play at local group evenings and dances.

Away from music Roy, who was born in Sutton, St. Helens before moving to Rainford where he spent all his married life, gained a scholarship to Cowley Boys school and went on to study Chemistry at Liverpool University. After leaving university Roy taught Chemistry at Cowley School rising to Head of Department and then went on to become a lecturer at Padgate Teacher Training College where he stayed until his retirement.

Roy devoted much of his life to youth work and was the founder and Scout Leader of the 8th Sutton Scouts. Over the years he organised many activities which included musical events, pantomimes, theatrical events and regular summer camps and in 2011 a new scout den was opened by Roy. As always Rene was by his side and she obtained the bricks for the new building from a local brickworks which was due for closure.

Roy and Rene loved Scotland and had a holiday home at Invergarry for over 40 years. As always Roy and Rene immersed themselves in the life of the local community and they took part in many of the music and dance events which were held in the area. Whilst in Scotland Roy was able to pursue his passion for photography and at home was a member of the St. Helens Camera club.

Roy and Rene were married for more than 50 years and were a devoted couple. Roy missed Rene greatly after she died but continued to remain active until his health began to fail. Sadly Roy left us on the 13th September 2019. We will miss him.

Thanks to Iris Critchley for providing a copy of her eulogy which she read at Roy's funeral.
